



2008 Award for the Best Dissertation Proposal in International Finance



The Indiana University (IU) Center for International Business Education and Research (CIBER) and the Financial Management Association International are sponsoring a competition for the best dissertation proposal in international finance. The winning dissertation will receive an award of \$2,500.

Guidelines for the Best Dissertation Proposal in International Finance

- Doctoral candidates with accepted proposals in International Finance are encouraged to apply for this award. Submitted dissertation proposals must contain clear international business content and/or implications.
- The author must have defended, or will defend, the dissertation **no later than December 30, 2008**.
- **The deadline for application is July 1, 2008.**
- A letter of recommendation must accompany dissertations from the PhD student's dissertation committee chair. Letters of recommendation from dissertation chairs must be sent to FMA via mail.
- **ONLY electronic applications will be accepted.**
- Applications must be accompanied by a **maximum four (4) to six (6) page** dissertation summary in PDF format.
- A copy of the winning dissertation must be provided to the IU CIBER.

Complete dissertations will not be eligible for the award.
